As you all are well aware of the fact that a new team of PCCTU took over the charge just after the General House meeting held at Sikh National College, Banga on 07th August, 2022. I would like to take this opportunity to wish all the elected members the best for the new session 2022-24. I pay my gratitude to the outgoing team including all the office bearers, EC members and District Presidents who worked very hard during their tenure from 2020 to 2022. I am highly thankful to all my worthy colleagues who have shown faith in me and assigned me a new work as General Secretary of this renowned organization. I assure you all that our hard work will meet your expectations.

Friends, the university and college teachers in Punjab are facing a very tough time these days. Recommendations of the seventh central pay commission in 2016 have not yet been implemented by the state government; rather the new incumbents have been forced to accept delinking from the UGC. Our organization is trying hard to fulfil the teachers' expectations and their genuine demands as per the central/state rules. But the wilful defaulting attitude of the state government is posing serious concerns for our community. This happened with the teachers during the Congress government in Punjab. Congress party ditched and betrayed the teaching community as well as the people of Punjab.
