GRANT IN AID RULES

Terms and Conditions of the financial grant to be given to the Private Colleges on the basis of 95% of the deficit.

- 1. The grant shall be available only to a college, which was in existence on 1.09.1978 within the area of the Punjab State and which was affiliated to the Punjab University, the Punjabi University or Guru Nanak Dev University on or before that date. The grant shall be available to such a college in respect of posts in existence in the college on 01.11.1977, on the condition that these posts have been created in accordance with the norms by the University or the Government and incumbents are not being paid salaries out of the students funds.
- 2. The college must not allow its income from the approved resources to fall below the level of such income during financial year 1977-78 to fall below the level of such income during financial year 1977-78. Where the income of a college falls below the level of 1977-73 on account of the decrease in students enrolment as a result of strict adherence to university norms. This will not be taken as a lapse on the part of the college. Income of the college shall include admission fee, tuition fee (received directly or through reimbursement), late admission fee, late payment fine, fines received from students, grant in aid received by the college under the UGC salary scale scheme or under any other scheme from the Govt. or the UGC for payment of salary and allowance of the teaching and non-teaching staff.
- 3. The approved items of expenditure shall be as follows:-
 - (i) Pay and allowance of the teaching and non teaching staff
 - (ii) Contribution towards the provident fund of the employees.
 - (iii) Lecturers in the colleges who were in position as on 20.06.75 who did not posses, at the time of the initial recreatment minimum qualifications as prescribed by the University concerned shall be required to attain these qualifications. If they are unable to do so unnual increment shall not be allowed w.e.f. 1.3.1982. Those lecturers to a were recruited after 30.6.75 shall also be required to improve their minimum qualifications

prescribed by the University within the period of five years, failing which their annual increment will also be stopped till they satisfy this condition.

- For future, only such candidates shall be appointed to the posts of lecturers and Principals as have the qualifications prescribed. All such appointments shall be made on merit and on the basis of open advertisement. The Selection Committee for the post of lecturer shall consist of:
 - a) Chairman, Governing Body of the college or of his nominee.
 - b) A nomince of the Vice Chancellor who should be an expert in the subject.
 - c) Principal of the college.
 - d) A representative of the Director of Public !...truction, Pb. Chandigarh
 - e) One subject expert to be detailed by the $\Omega_{\rm s}^{-1}$ (Colleges).

No selection shall be considered valid unions at least one representative of the Director, Public Instruction @ is present. Recommendations of the selection committee shall be subject to ' approval of the Director of Public Instruction Punjab. All appointment of principals of colleges shall be made by a Selection Committee consistion of the following:-

- Adhoc appointments to posts on account eave vacancies may be made by the Principals through the Em Coment Exchange or Open advertisement subject to the condition that he selected candidates have the qualifications as prescribed by the UGC. - The period of probation of a teacher st. in no case be more than 24 months. The executive Council of the Governing Body of the college may for reasons to be recorded waive the condition of probation.

- The teaching staff of the college shall be said salaries according to the revised UGC pay scales approved by the aute Government. The teaching and the non-teaching staff be given salaries every month by cheque and no member of the staff shall be compelled to pay or refund directly or indirectly any part of the salary admissible to him under the rules.

Out of this he will spent at least 20 hours of work in a week on the premises of the college for teaching and guidance of students. This would be sillect to provision that a teacher may be detained in the college beyond this limit in the interest of work.
- 19. No member of teaching or non-teaching staff shall be allowed pay scales higher than those prescribed by the Govt. 1 in corresponding posts in the Govt. colleges. If higher grades have alread been allowed in a college, the differential of salary shall be borne by the iagement concerned.
- 20. The Principal of the college shall submit to Punjab Utilization Certificate and disbute. the Chartered Accountant including the si obtaining the next grant under the scheme.
