CIRCULAR

My Dear friends

We have been marching through a tough time as the Punjab government has started reducing our salary grant without any reason. All of you have been participating in an agitation against the government with full strength and I hope our struggle will bring a bright future ahead and the issue of retirement age/reduction in the grant from 60 years to 58 years will be resolved in teachers' favor.

In March 2022, with the formation of AAP government in Punjab, we started lobbying for the implementation of the 7th pay commission and got it implemented in October 2022. But, unfortunately, the Punjab government added a confusing clause 13(ii) which raised concerns regarding the age of retirement. After the said notification, we again started lobbying to get above-said clause rectified by the government and side wise also initiated the agitation. Many official and unofficial meetings were carried out with the government nominees but no concrete result has been received till now. Since the Punjab government is not keeping an ear to our just and genuine demand, we have decided to intensify our ongoing agitation.

JOINT ACTION COMMITTEE

A joint action committee including Management federations, Principals association and PCCTU was formed to fight against callous attitude of Punjab government against higher education. In a meeting of Joint Action Committee on 9/1/2023 and PFUCTO on 10/1/2023, it was decided to observe complete boycott of evaluation work on 16thJanuary, 2023.

On 18th January all Non-Govt. Aided and Unaided colleges were closed under the slogan "Total Education Bandh" (Including Examination Boycott) and submitted memorandum to respective Deputy Commissioners. Also, teachers of all the Govt. Colleges and all the five state universities observed two hours Campus Dharna from 12:00 noon to 2:00 pm.

EC Meeting:

An emergent online meeting of the Executive Committee was organized on 1/2/2023 at 7:00pm and the protest program as follows was given:

- 1. 6th February: Stay in strike and Dharna in front of gate from 12.00pm to 2.00pm
- 2. 7th February: Black Badges as announced by JAC earlier.
- 3. 9th February: Students to be educated in 3rd and 4th period in class rooms regarding concerns related to Higher Education particularly reduction in salary grant.
- 4. 10th February: Complete Education Bandh and stay in strike as announced by JAC.

 Principals' associations also extended support to PCCTU actions programme on 6th February and 9th
 February 2023.

JAC MEETING

As decided by the Joint Action Committee in its meeting held at Khalsa College Amritsar, the given plan of protest was followed:

- 1. 15th February: College teachers including Principals and management members observed complete bandh of the colleges and organized stay-in-strike and Dharna at the respective college gates from 10:00 AM to 2:00PM.
- 2. 16th February: College teachers along with Principals and management members hold the protest march to the office of the Deputy Commissioners in all Districts at 12:30 PM.

MEETING WITH OFFICIALS

7th February, 2023

A meeting with Finance Minister was scheduled on 7/2/2023 at 3:00pm in the Secretariat Chandigarh. However, due to some unknown reasons, FM was not available at that time, so meeting was chaired by Principal Secretary, Finance. The delegation comprising Dr. Gurdas Singh Sekhon, General Secretary PCCTU, Dr. Jagwant Singh, General Secretary PFUCTO and Prof. Bhupinder Singh, Finance Secretary PCCTU explained all issues to him. PS, Finance raised some questions which were replied to his satisfaction. He told the delegation that the proceedings will be apprised to FM with a positive note.

16TH February

Our President Dr. Vinay Sophat met Education Minister S. Harjot Singh Bains at Ludhiana. Minister assured that the age of retirement will remain 60.

21st February, 2023

A meeting was scheduled with Principal Secretary, Chief Minister Punjab on 21/2/2023. Our President Dr. Vinay Sophat, Dr. Jagwant Singh General Secretary PFUCTO and Dr. Vikas Teji met Principal Secretary Chief Minister Punjab, Sh. A Veenu Prasad at Secretariat Chandigarh. Principal Secretary Finance Sh. Ajoy Kumar Sinha was also the part of that meeting. We discussed the issue of retirement age along with grant in detail and put our viewpoint regarding the issue.

During this period our many teachers across the state also met Education minister and got the same assurance but still no concrete outcome is there. So PCCTU in its EC meeting held on 22^{nd} February decided to intensify the agitation.

EC Meeting:

An online meeting of Executive Committee was held on 22/02/2023 at 10:30 am and following decisions have been taken to intensify the agitation:

- 1. On 24th, 25th and 27th February 2023, District Presidents and EC members will hold offline meetings with their respective Units in their colleges by mutually assigning colleges to each EC member/ District President. The teachers will be motivated to participate in this long battle with 100 percent presence in all the actions.
- 2. On 24th, 25th, 26th and 27th February 2023, **Letters to raise questions will be given to all MLA's** of both ruling and opposition parties to raise the issue in the Assembly during assemble session which is to be held from 3rd March, 2023. District Presidents and EC Members will ensure in their districts/Areas to do the same. PDF file of the letter is attached herewith.
- 3. On 28th February 2023, **Candle March** will be organized in all the districts which will start at 6:00 pm with banners/placards and candles. Venue and route will be intimated by the district President/EC member.
- 4. On 2nd March 2023, **Two hours Dharna** from 12:00 to 2:00 pm in front of **AAP office/halqa in-charge of AAP** will be held in all the districts Headquarters/Cities.
- 5. On 6th March, Campus Dharna from 12:00 to 2:00 pm for mobilization of march to assembly on 7th March, 2023.
- 6. On 7th March 2023, **March to Assembly**. All the teachers will observe **Mass Causal Leave** and reach Chandigarh SECTOR 25 NEAR CREMATION GROUND at 11.30am sharp. All will march to gherao Assembly.
- 7. On 10th March 2023, Press Conferences in all the Districts at 4:00 pm in all the Districts/Cities. All the units will issue the press note.
- 8. On 16th March 2023, **Black flag March on the occasion of G20** meet at Amritsar. All the teachers will reach Amritsar. Time and venue will be intimated later on.
- 9. On 17th March 2023, Resolution to be passed in AIFUCTO Conference, Kurukshetra Haryana against double standards of APP Government towards higher education in Punjab and expose their intensions all over India.
- 10. On 23rd March 2023, blood samples by 51 teachers to be offered at the feet of **S. Bahagat Singh at Khatkar kalan where CM took oath to guard the ideas of S. Bhagat Singh but now doing otherwise.** So in protest against the anti-teacher and anti-higher education policies of Punjab Government. The agitation will be intensified further.
